

Ruth Holder to Speak to Carroll County Historical Society

March 18th 6:30 PM at Stallings Community Center Lions Parks Room

Ruth Holder, co-author of A History of Temple, Georgia - A West Georgia Town of Carroll County, will



present her program on the Temple, GA history. She is a Carroll County native from the Flat Rock community and was educated in the schools at Flat Rock, Villa Rica, and West Georgia College. Afterwards, she earned her graduate degree at the University of Georgia.

While at West Georgia College she met and married Burwell Holder, her coauthor in 1952. For the next forty years she taught school and served as a librarian in the Paulding and Carroll County Schools. Miss Foster with the West Georgia College Library asked her to write a history of Temple for a new book on Carroll County. Their first book was published in 1976 with a 1982 update for the Temple Centennial celebration. Upon retirement in 1993, Ruth continued her interest in Temple's history. Ruth had collected so much information and photographs that she revised and expanded the book again in a June 2013 release.

The book is available in both Kindle electronic and printed versions.
