The Whooping Creek Primitive Baptist Church was founded in 1852. The altar and pews were saved from the wooden Carroll County Courthouse on the square when it burned. The pews were made from 24 inch boards. The altar was converted from the judge's bench. Benjamin and Joyce Merrell will tell us the history of the church and its furnishings and the cemetery located across the road.

The meeting will include a report on the progress made by the Board on several projects during the summer recess.

Directions: On **Hwy 16** South go to Clem and turn Right on Clem-Lowell Road; turn Right on Whooping Creek Road. Church is on Left in about 3 miles.

On **Hwy 27** go South past John Deere Tractor dealer and turn Left on Lowell Rd; after 200 feet turn Left on Whooping Creek Rd. Church is on Right in about 3 miles.
